## **ANDREW KING, 2003 winner of the Prix de Rome, to speak at the Design Exchange**

Toronto, Ontario: September 19, 2003

On Monday September 22, the DX will present a lecture by Andrew King, Calgary architectural designer and winner of this year's distinguished Prix de Rome, presented by the Canada Council. The Prix de Rome recognizes the work of an individual or collective actively engaged in the field of contemporary architecture whose work shows exceptional talent. The award, established in 1987, enables the winner to pursue independent work in Rome and make an original contribution to the development of the discipline.

Mr. King was selected for the award on the basis of his proposal to study the gates of Rome from an architectural, sociological and cultural perspective. His work will touch on such themes as the use of public space, the conditions of exile and displacement and the relationship between architecture and cultural spectacles, such as theatre and cinema
