**DESIGN EXCHANGE PRESENTS “DIANA, A

Toronto, Ontario: The Design Exchange (DX) announces the opening of a new exhibit, **Diana, A Celebration**. This award-winning exhibit will be on display at the Design Exchange from December 19, 2003 for a limited run.

The DX is a centre for design exhibitions, education and research. It is located in the former Toronto Stock Exchange building, a historic site that is a classic example of art moderne architecture. The DX is a not-for-profit organization that promotes the awareness of design in all disciplines, including fashion, industrial design, interior design, architecture and graphic design. The DX carries out its mandate by presenting exhibitions, public and educational programs, seminars, competitions and research. The DX is located at 234 Bay Street, south of King, in downtown Toronto.

As Canada’s design museum, the DX is ideally suited to host this exhibit, which reflects Diana’s own impact on the world of design and fashion. **Diana, A Celebration** includes a ‘Style and Fashion’ section with 28 of Diana’s exquisite designer gowns and suits by British and international designers. The highlight of this section is her resplendent royal wedding gown designed by David and Elizabeth Emanuel. The DX is also the ideal location as the venue itself reflects style and elegance in its own architecture and design.

Some of the proceeds of the exhibit will go to support the DX’s public and educational programming.
